## HEALTH CHECK

A helpful form to fill in when checking your bunnies health

<b>Nose clean &amp; dry</b> (Check no discharge)			<b>Tail &amp; bottom clean &amp; dry</b> Use a comb and baby wipes to clean		
<b>Eyes clean &amp; bright</b> Runny eye/s? Take them to see the vet			<b>Clean out scent glands</b> Use a damp cotton bud		
<b>Ears clean &amp; dry</b> Check for wax or ear mites (dark crust)			<b>Trim fur around bottom area if needed</b> Use curved scissors		
<b>Give a good brush all over</b> Brush out any matted fur - never cut off			<b>Apply fly strike spray</b>		
<b>Skin/fur even &amp; shiny</b> Check for dandruff which could be mites			<b>Check droppings</b> Check no signs of diarrhea or a change in shape to droppings		
<b>Feet clean &amp; dry?</b> Check for sore patches or matted fur			<b>Check for wet fur around sides of mouth</b> Could mean dental problems		
<b>Check for abscesses/lumps all over</b> Especially around ears, eyes and jaw			<b>Check for small lumps along jaw line</b> Could be dental problems		
<b>Check for inflamed skin</b> Red skin patches that feel hot could be the start of an abscess			<b>Check if nails need trimming</b> Shouldn't be longer than their fur
